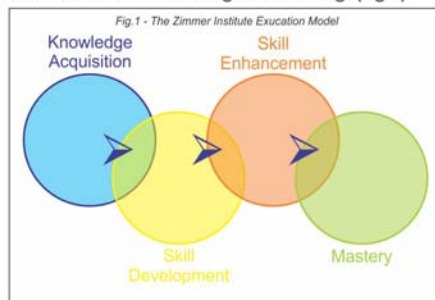

## 2012 Zimmer Institute – Educational Model and Course Nomenclature

At the Zimmer Institute (ZI), our goal is to provide educational opportunities for health care professionals at any level they need; programs that fit within an education model focused on four stages of learning. (Fig 1)

Participants can take programs in any stage of the model based on their experience and desired learning goals. To simplify the selection process, the ZI has created a course naming structure with four (4) types of programs, which correspond to the model illustrated above. These include:

- Instructional Courses
- Masterclass Programs
- Expert Interactions Programs
- Surgeon-to-Surgeon (S2S) Programs



**Instructional Courses** address relevant concepts and

techniques that comprise the foundation for the development of new and more complex surgical skills. New primary surgical approach or implant system should take an instructional course in that technique or product. Products and/or procedure are covered through lecture, small group discussions and exercises, hands-on sawbones labs and occasionally cadaveric training. Instructional courses also address relevant anatomical and physiological considerations, clinical efficacy and representative clinical examples. These courses tap into the Knowledge Acquisition and Skill Development stages of the Education Model.

**MasterClass** programming builds on previous skills, knowledge and involves the comparison of various surgical and treatment approaches, as well application of more complex skills and knowledge in more open environments. This type of course covers the Skill Development and Enhancement stages of the ZI model. Product is incorporated as a solution to surgical problems/issues with a "problem first" focus and more complex problem solving discussions than in Instructional Courses. Basic and intermediate revision procedures and issues are introduced at the MasterClass level. Other topics can include advanced anatomical considerations, surgical technique philosophy, diagnostic overviews, comparative treatment options and rationale, multiple product comparisons, relevant clinical cases, and surgical technique reviews.

**Expert Interactions** programs consist of the most advanced level of education and focus on the refinement of skills and knowledge through real-time problem-solving activities, focusing on advanced theory and practice of surgery. In line with the ZI model, Interactions programs focus on the Skill Enhancement and Mastery stages. Emphasis is placed on the development of strategies and the refinement of skills to the expert level by intense interaction with expert faculty members. A higher percentage of these programs is open for dialogue and discussion with sample topics including complex revision arthroplasty, complex fracture management, complex clinical pathways/continuum of care, and in-depth product specifications. These programs are both cadaveric and non-cadaveric programs depending on the need for surgical skill application.

**Surgeon-To-Surgeon** programs focus on advanced learning in the operating room environment with the participant attending a day or more of observation in an expert faculty member's OR. Emphasis is placed on the development of strategies and the refinement of procedural understanding to the expert level, or Mastery stages in the ZI model. Sample topics include pre-operative templating, anatomical considerations, and complex clinical pathways/continuum of care, specific procedural instruction, and in-depth product specifications. S2S programs are primarily designed for high level interaction, but in specific instances may be used to introduce a customer to the use of a product or procedure. Instructional courses and Zimmer Cadaveric Practice Workshops are more applicable formats for products/procedure introductions. S2S programs are not outlined in this document but can be scheduled directly through your local Zimmer representative.
